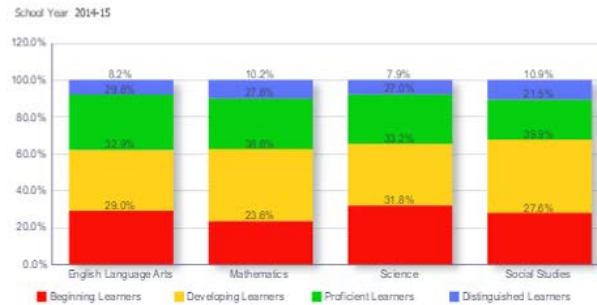

- **22.2% of graduates are college ready.**

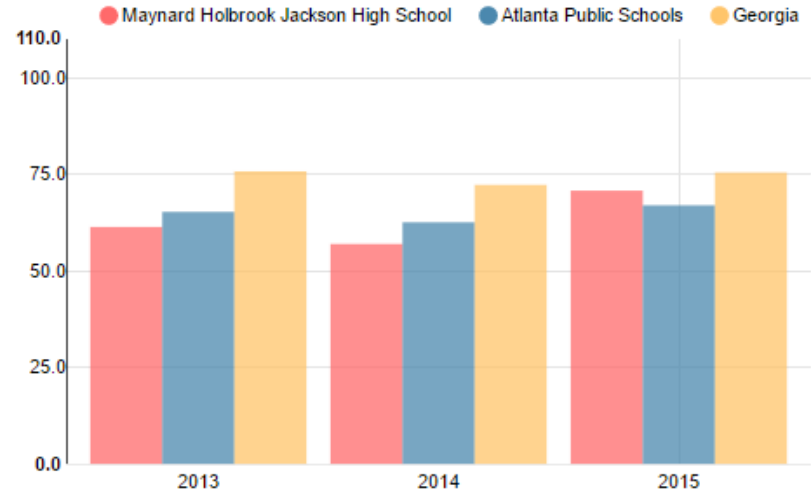

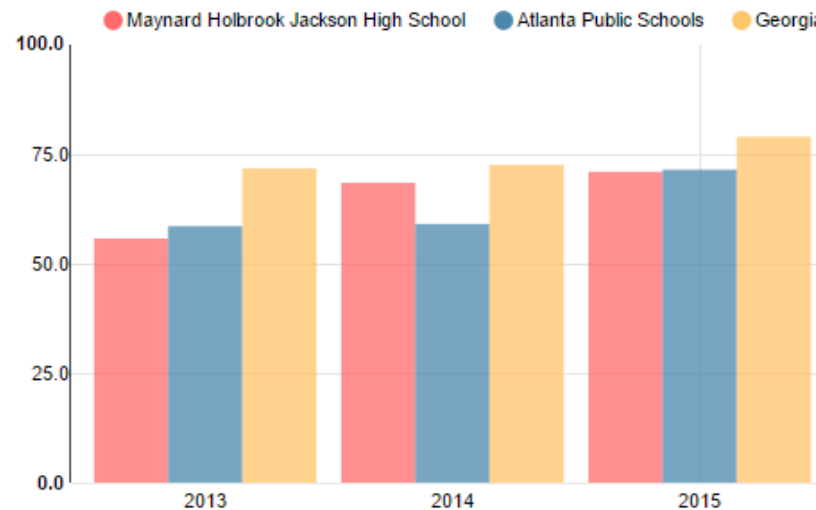
