College and Career Readiness Performance Index (CCRPI)

- First issued in 2012 as a school rating between 0 and 110.
- Includes many indicators under the four components below.
- Indicators in each component differ at the Elementary, Middle, and High School levels.

Progress	40
Achievement Gap	10
Challenge	10

- **22.2% of graduates are college ready.**

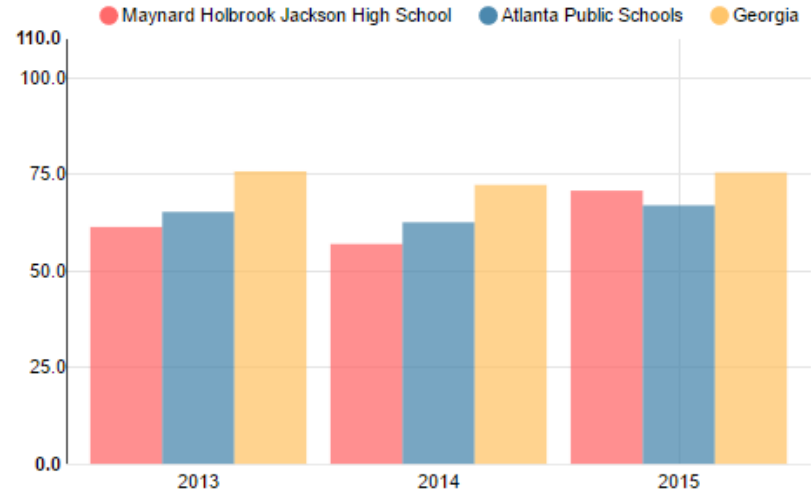

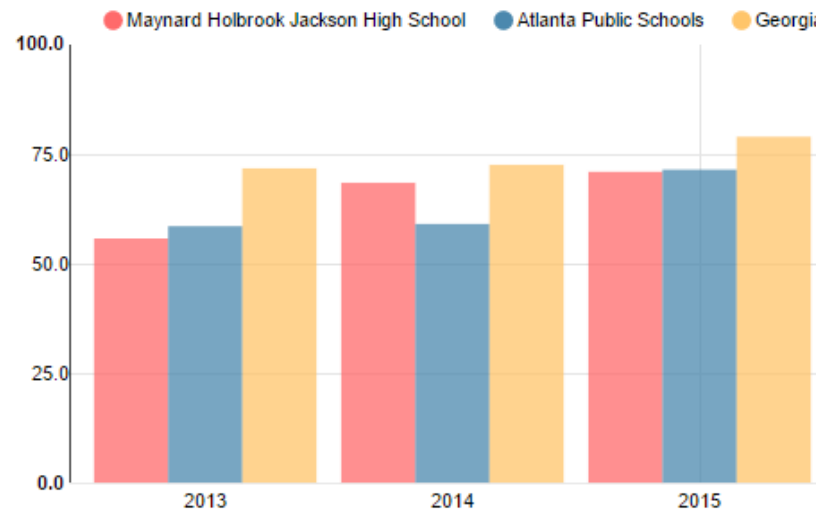
